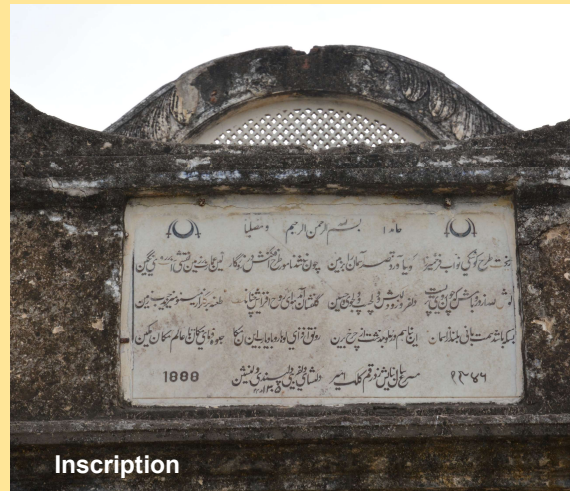


# LOHARU FORT, BHIWANI

## Loharu Fort, Bhiwani

16<sup>th</sup> century CE

Loharu fort is the chief monument in Bhiwani. It is said to have been built in 1570 by Arjan Singh. A number of gateways and the fort wall still exist. The exterior wall is punctuated with massive circular bastions at intervals. A structure known as the Nawab's palace was built inside the fort in 1890. The building of the palace is a mixture of oriental and western styles. The building is single – storeyed and the layout is square and symmetrical. The openings are arches with cusped profile. Four minarets are located at all corners, and it is covered with domes. It stands on a raised terrace, with a fountain and a tank in its centre.
