Monument

The Baoli locally known as '*Bhai Ki Baoli*' is made out of *lakhauri* bricks with *lime-surkhi*. This three-storeyed building is in the shape of a step-well. It is approached by descending flight of steps leading down to the well. The well is three-storeyed and is open from two sides. It is covered with a domical roof. The steps have thick wall on the either side which are decorated. As the name of this monument itself indicates, it was built by Bhai rulers (1767-1843 AD) of Kaithal State for the use of the general public.
