CITIZEN CHARTER

The Department of Archaeology and Museums, Haryana with its Headquarter at Chandigarh came in existence in 1972. Archaeological excavations, explorations, protection & conservation of ancient & historical monuments/sites and museum activities are the main functions of the department. Under the museum activities the department documents, the antiquities and treat them chemically, establishes museums for displaying ancient art objects, provide research facilities and organizes exhibition at various places in the state making replicas of scultures to create general awareness in public. Other activities of the department include the publication of popular and research literature on new discoveries.

There are a total of 32 State protected monuments and sites, 5 Zonal Museums (Jahaj Kothi at Hisar, Jayanti Devi Temple at Jind, Barh Khalsa at Rai, Martial Art Museum at Kapalmochan, Chhotu Ram Samarak at Garhi Sampla) and 1 Site Museum (Bhima Devi at Pinjore).

1. The above mentioned museums houses sculptures, terracottas and pottery of various periods. The museum remains open for the general public from 9 A.M to 5 P.M. during all the working days. The departmental publications are also supplied to the researchers and general public free of cost.

MUSEUMS ACTIVITIES

The department plays a vital role in the preservation of ancient heritage. A state Museum is being set up in Panchkula. The antiquities like sculptures, terracottas, coins and other archaeological material will be

displayed in this museum. In addition to the state museum, the department has been set up a site museum at Bhima Devi Temple, Pinjore. This site museum is situated near Yadvendra Gardens and remains open for general public. The site museum at Bhima Devi Temple, Pinjore will house the ancient temple remains of the site belonging to the c. 9-12th Cent. A.D. of Gurjara Prtihar Art. This art is of great tourist attraction because of close proximately to the Yadvendra Gardens. Five Zonal Museums have already been set up in Jahaj Kothi at Hisar, Jayanti Devi Temple at Jind, Barh Khalsa at Rai, Martial Art Museum at Kapalmochan, Chhotu Ram Samarak at Garhi Sampla. All the museums remain open for the general public during the working days from 9-00 A.M. to 5-00 P.M.

RESEARCH FACILITIES:-

The department has imparted practical training of archaeological excavations to the (M.A.) students of M.D. University, Kurukshetra. The Brief reports of excavations collected at Kunal, (Fatehabad) Jogna Khera, (Kurukshetra), Banawali (Hisar) and Sugh (Yamunanagar) is ready and made available to the researches in due course of time.

DEFINITION OF ANTIQUITIES:

- (i) Any coin, sculpture, epigraph or other work of art or craftsmanship;
- (ii) Any article, object or thing detached from a building or cave;
- (iii) Any article, object or thing illustrative of science, art. Crafts, literature, religion, custom, morals or politic in bygone ages;
- (iv) Any article, object or thing of historical interest;
- (v) Any article, object or thing declared by the Central Government, by notification in the official Gazette, to be an antiquity for the purposes of this Act, which has been inexistence for not-less than one hundred years, and
- (vi) Any manuscript, record or other document which is of scientific, historical, literary or aesthetic value and which has been in existence for not less than seventy-five years;
