

DEHRA MANDIR, FIROJPUR JHIRKHA, MEWAT, NUH

Dehra Mandir 1451 AD

Monument

The temple was possibly constructed in 1451 AD (*Samvat* 1508) as can be inferred from an inscription fixed on the upper portion of the entrance of the pillared hall (*Sabhamandapa*) of the temple. This temple consists of three sanctum-sanctorums for the three Tirthankars; a pillared hall and a circumambulatory path (*Pradakshinapath*). The temple architecture appears to be heavily influenced by then prevailing Lodhi style of architecture.
