

ANCIENT SITE, KUNAL, FATEHABAD

Ancient Site of Kunal, Fatehabad 5700-6000 B.C

Site

The site was discovered in the year 1981. The Archaeological excavations at this pre-Harappan site which is 8000 years old (C14 dates 5700-6000 B.C) was started in the year 1986. After in between few gap years, excavation was conducted till 2018-19.

The recent excavation seasons yielded three successive phases of occupation; from pit dwelling to that of square and rectangular mud brick houses, which are supposed to be the earliest remains of pre-Harappan culture in India. Also copper furnace, steatite bead making workshop and kiln were found. A hoard of regalia objects including gold beads of a necklace, an armlet and a few bangle pieces and beads of semi-precious stones is first of its kind in the region of Haryana.

Notable objects of silver have also been found from the site.
