TOMB OF CHAR QUTUB, HANSI, HISSAR

<u>Dargah Char Qutub Complex</u> <u>circa 12th to 14th century AD</u>

Monument

A group of monuments, situated to the west of the town are known as Dargah Char-Qutub. Jamal-ud-Din Hanswi (1187-1261 AD), Burhan-ud Din (1261-1303 AD), Qutab-ud-Din Munawwar (1300-1354 AD) and Nur-ud-Din or Nur-e-Jahan (1325-1397 AD) were the celebrated Sufi Saints of their times and designated as 'Qutubs'. This monument celebrates the last resting place of these four saints. One of the most imposing edifices of this complex is the large mosque in the northern enclosure, which was constructed by Firoz Shah Tughlag. In the complex are the twin tombs of Begum Skinner and chhatris (two kiosks) known as Char Diwan and Ek Diwan.
