TOMB OF SHAH NIZAM, NARNAUL, MAHENDRAGARH

Tomb of Shah Nizam circa 16th century AD

Monument

This tomb was built during the reign of Mughal Emperor Akbar (1556 –1605 AD). Akbar is believed to be a great devotee of this celebrated saint and he used to visit him frequently on his way to Ajmer. An inscription in Persian fixed over the doorway records the date of demise of the saint as AH 997 (1589 AD) in chronogram and figures.

The mosque within the tomb compound was constructed in AH 1031 (1662 AD) by person called Niamatullah as can be gathered from the inscription in Persian fixed on the entrance of the mosque. Some of walls and ceiling of the mosque depict painting in floral motifs. The tomb and mosque was built in rubble masonry covered with thick lime plaster.
