Monument

It is a fine example of Indo-British Architecture constructed on the occasion of Queen Victoria's visit to Karnal. The hall is a unique combination of architectural styles – Indo-Islamic and European. This complete structure is surrounded by a pillared Verandah. Verandah's arches are good example of Islamic architecture. There are four porticos on all the sides of building and outside of the pillared verandah. Though, it is a single storey building but gives look of a double storeyed structure from the outside.
